WHAT IS ELUMEN?

- eLumen is a digital platform for storing and working with curriculum and, potentially, assessment.
- This semester (spring of 2020), a handful of faculty volunteers will be testing the eLumen assessment module to assess its feasibility.

WHAT STAYS THE SAME?

- Faculty evaluators continue to participate in scheduling the four-year assessment plan
- Evaluators conduct CLO assessment in their sections
- Evaluators score individual students and then compile the number of students at each mastery level

WHAT'S DIFFERENT?

- Assessment data entered in one report for each section taught, allowing all instructors to enter data.
- Evaluators answer questions embedded in the assessment report to reflect on the results of assessment – *this is pre-dialogue*
- Reflections are analyzed by division coordinators, who may create an action plan to facilitate dialog (*kind of like opening a loop*)
 - Program level action plans pushed out to division and/or department coordinators
 - Course level action plans pushed out to course coordinators (for high volume courses)
- Action plan responses analyzed at program review and then PR plans created

LOOKING AHEAD: IMPLICATIONS FOR CR'S ASSESSMENT PRACTICE

- The new four-year cycle
 - Coordinated planning with division coordinators
 - Consider assessing all outcomes in one semester...?
- No more stand-alone program level assessment reports
- Planning outcome improvement occurs at program review level ... no more course level open loops
 - Course level assessment data, reflections, and action plans all funnel into the initiation of course- and program-driven plans
